
Few artists in the history of modern art have taken upon themselves the task of exploring the magical potential of hinges as a way to open up the pictorial surface of painting as seriously and extensively as Katsumi Nakai (1927–2013).

Born in the town of Hirakata, Japan, Nakai was fueled by a strong desire to travel, settling eventually in the city of Milan, Italy, where he would spend the most prolific decades of his career (between 1964 and 1996). Initially working in expressive abstract style, by the mid 1960s Nakai developed a unique approach to art making that relied on cutting and assembling wooden panels using hinges to create paintings of exceptional complexity. As such, his work provides a unique alternative to the typical tendencies associated with Italy of the 1960s and 70s, merging local Spatialist sensibilities with those of North American Minimalist, Color Field, and Hard-Edge painting, as well as ancient traditions of craft making, European and Asian alike.

The present display forms part of a larger exhibition, held at Luxembourg + Co., New York, (Fuller Building, 595 Madison Av.) in which works by Katsumi Nakai as well as Isamu Noguchi (1904–1988) are presented in dialogue, bringing to the fore Japanese traditions of craft that immigrated in the second half of the 20th Century into the realm of European and North American art.




Hiraku 54 Osaka, 1981







Untitled, 2012


