

At Frieze Seoul 2024, MASSIMODECARLO's booth will showcase two focus sections: one dedicated to American painter Shannon Cartier Lucy and the second to a group presentation of figurative painting, along with a selection of works by other international artists from the gallery's roster.

Shannon Cartier Lucy's new works delve into themes of intimacy and tension, focusing on hands depicted in intricate, ambiguous interactions that suggest both connection and entanglement.

The figurative section includes works by contemporary artists such as Diane Dal-Pra, Lenz Geerk, Tomoo Gokita, Jessie Homer French, France-Lise McGurn, and Mimmo Paladino. This eclectic mix dives into the age-old genre of portraiture, exploring the ever-elusive concept of identity. The presentation spans from sculptural pieces to fluid figures floating on the canvas, from stylised shapes emerging from enigmatic backgrounds to whimsical faces seemingly pulled from dreams. By exploring these varied expressions, the presentation highlights how portraiture has evolved in contemporary art. Navigating the fine line between appearance and reality, each work provides a fresh perspective on what it means to be seen and recognised in a world where identity is as fluid as the paint on the canvas.

Additionally, the booth will feature ceramic masterpieces by Korean artist Yeesookyung, abstract works by Hejum Bä, Massimo Bartolini's poetic *Rugiade* (*Dews*), Rob Pruitt's diverse conceptual pieces, and Jean-Marie Appriou's sculptures that blend archaic and futuristic elements, among other notable works.







FocusShannon Cartier Lucy

Shannon Cartier Lucy (b.1977, USA) has the unique ability to combine mystery, discomfort and intimacy in compositions that are both familiar as minutely staged. Drawing inspiration from the small absurdities of daily life, Cartier Lucy's subtly hallucinatory paintings are characterized by the soft clarity of her painterly style.

In the new works presented for the first time at Frieze Seoul, the artist focuses her attention on hands. Holding hands is a simple gesture of affection, companionship, yet upon closer inspection, it appears that both hands belong to the same person, perhaps the artist. It becomes unclear whether these hands are calmly intertwined in a serene embrace, or perhaps intertwined, stuck in a paralyzing knot. In another work, hands appear reluctantly, set against what could be a still life with a cup of tea and a moving candle. Although almost relegated to the background, these hands still indicate a presence - a hesitant self-portrait, perhaps. The artist's presence is figuratively and literally signaled by their hands, which are both the painting itself and the means by which it was created. As Cartier Lucy explains, "my paintings are each a sort of a self-portrait. I like to portray my truth. I feel like I can only be completely honest if I'm speaking from my point of view. I'm not ready to speak for anyone but myself".

With a career spanning over twenty years, Shannon Cartier Lucy's work is one of endless experimentation. She has been represented by MASSIMODECARLO since 2021, has participated in one group show with the gallery (2021) and presented two solo exhibitions since, in Hong Kong (2021) and at Casa Corbellini-Wassermann in Milan (2022).








