Adams and Ollman

Marlon Mullen Art Basel Miami Beach December 4–8, 2024 Booth NO2 For Art Basel Miami Beach, Adams and Ollman presents a solo exhibition of new paintings by American artist Marlon Mullen. With a career spanning nearly 40 years, Mullen creates paintings characterized by graphic lines, bold color, and a uniquely rigorous approach to organizing the picture plane into innovative compositions. In these dense and tactile works, language and other loosely recognizable signs materialize and then dissolve as he translates his original referent—often a found image from art magazines—into complex abstractions that prioritize formal concerns over legibility.

This presentation coincides with *Projects: Marlon Mullen*, the first solo exhibition of the artist's work by a major museum, curated by Ann Temkin with Alexandra Morrison at The Museum of Modern Art (MoMA) in New York which will be on view from December 14, 2024 through April 20, 2025.

Mullen's newest paintings on view at Art Basel Miami Beach draw from the covers of Art In America, Frieze, and Artforum magazines from the library at Nurturing Independence Through Artistic Development (NIAD) in Richmond, California, a progressive art studio for adult artists with developmental disabilities, where Mullen has worked since 1986. A strong formalist, Mullen paints precise shapes in bold swirls of vivid colors. As he distills and reconstructs his source material, the paintings withhold what might be considered vital information, prioritizing previously minor or overlooked details. Text is rendered not necessarily to be read, but rather as imagery that performs an aesthetic or poetic function, while topographical pools of paint and graphic lines delineate forms that had formerly served to make an image. Mullen approaches both his sources and paintings as dimensional objects, rendering magazine barcodes and wrapping the painting around the edge to correspond with the magazine's spine.


Mullen liberates the components of his paintings from any purpose other than generating composition, gesture, and rhythm. His specific use of color, gesture, and abstraction creates an embodied conversation between the artist, his source material, and the viewer. Through his radical transmutations, the artist creates his own idiosyncratic universe that toggles between representation and abstraction.

Marlon Mullen (b. 1963, Richmond, CA) lives in Rodeo, California. Solo exhibitions include *Projects: Marlon* Mullen at The Museum of Modern Art (MoMA), New York, NY (forthcoming); White Columns, New York, NY; the Atlanta Contemporary, Atlanta, GA; JTT, New York, NY and Adams and Ollman, Portland, OR. His work has been included in group exhibitions including the 2019 SECA Art Award exhibition, SFMOMA, San Francisco, CA; The Whitney Biennial 2019, Whitney Museum of American Art, New York, NY; Way Bay 2 and Create, UC Berkeley Art Museum and Pacific Film Archive (BAMPFA), Berkeley, CA; Affinity, Museum of Northern California Art, Chico, CA; and Under Another Name, The Studio Museum in Harlem, New York, NY. Mullen received the 2014 Wynn Newhouse Award. His work is in the collections of the Whitney Museum of American Art and The Museum of Modern Art, both New York, NY; San Francisco Museum of Modern Art, San Francisco, CA; Institute of Contemporary Art, Miami, FL; and Portland Art Museum, Portland, OR.

















