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Marie Catalano marie@adamsandollman.com +I 845 4I6 8499 Since 2013, Adams and Ollman has been fostering dialogues between diverse artistic practices that expand notions of what art can be. For Frieze London, the gallery will feature a cross-section of its dynamic program.

Joan Nelson will exhibit new fantastical landscapes alongside Rob Lyon's paintings that capture his walks in the South Downs. Mariel Capanna, soon to be featured in two U.S. institutional exhibitions, contributes performative works that explore intricate relationships between time, place, image, and memory. New paintings by Katherine Bradford, whose solo exhibition at the Kunsthalle Emden is currently on view, will be in dialogue with Kinke Kooi's strange and seductive works on paper featuring feminist motifs. Complementing this conversation will be Lynne Woods Turner's intimate drawings that bring to mind mathematical diagrams, and the female form.

The figures in **Katherine Bradford**'s (b. 1942, New York, NY, where she lives and works) paintings are informed by their surroundings—bodies of water, the night sky, or fields of color populated with abstract shapes and forms. Against these spaces that Bradford so skillfully creates, the artist's subjects assert themselves in moments of imagination or introspection as sites to consider gender, politics, sexuality, and, sometimes very simply, the nature of paint. Bradford offers the viewer hints of narrative, subjects, or feelings to reorganize and rework in order to create new meanings. Archetypal figures—mothers, dreamers, superheroes—appear throughout her work allowing us to consider the human condition in all of its faults and beauty, joy and pain. *Katherine Bradford: Sky Swimmers* is currently on view at Kunsthalle Emden in Emden, DE.

Mariel Capanna (b. 1988, Philadelphia, PA, where she lives and works) explores relationships between time, place, image, and memory through performative, reflexive painting. Working from direct observation of films and videos, Capanna indexes their moving images using gestures, symbols, and colors that reference and enact the constructive processes of memory via perception and engagement. This activity of watching while painting mimics the everyday challenge of simultaneously viewing and

experiencing the world around us. An accumulation of abstract marks and recognizable imagery—flags, cars, shoes, trees, strings—floats in a choreography of free association across a gradient sky-like surface. Her work will be featured in a forthcoming solo exhibition at the Clark Institute, Williamstown, MA.

Since the 1980s, **Kinke Kooi**'s (b. 1961, Leeuwarden, NL; lives and works in Arnhem, NL) works on paper have engaged with themes of gender, connection, and notions of the "other." She meticulously renders clamshells, pearls, flowers, seedpods, fleshy folds, and breasts in shades of pastel pinks, purples, and reds or striking yellows and greens with ornate and florid detail. In her intricate, inventive paintings and drawings, which might be read as an anthropomorphic garden, multi-faceted feminism is woven together with a seductive, sinewy line that blurs and merges inside and outside, convex and concave, surface and depth, ornament and function, emotional and verbal, high and low, flora and fauna. In 2023, Kooi was the recipient of the Gerrit Benner prize and the subject of a solo exhibition at the Fries Museum, Leeuwarden, Netherlands.

Rob Lyon (b. 1982, West Sussex, UK, where he lives and works) is a self-taught painter who, since 2014, has been painting the unique landscape around the South Downs in England. Moved by its distinct ridges of wooded, rolling hills and valleys, dramatic skies, and sweeping vistas, the artist captures the animistic, mystical qualities of the land with a series of simplified forms, expressive colors, strong lines, and patterned brushstrokes.

For nearly four decades, the subject of **Joan Nelson**'s work (b. 1958, El Segundo, CA, lives and works in Stamford, NY) has been the awe and artifice of landscape painting. Nelson employs a painterly maximalism to depict landforms, skies, and seas that are sublime and surreal, and touch on key themes of feminism, spiritualism, science fiction, and the environment. The landscapes she paints are familiar yet mysterious—they might be prehuman or post-apocalyptic, or from another planet altogether. Employing a rich palette of paint, glitter, ink, glass beads, and sometimes even

mascara, Nelson conjures luminous jewel-toned mountain ranges, craggy inland sea stacks, and towering, figurative basalt columns set against rich, effervescent skies that appear to be evolving before our eyes.

For nearly five decades, **Lynne Woods Turner** (b. 1951, Dallas, TX; lives and works in Portland, OR) has given shape to the hidden, the obscure, and the mysterious. Composed of meditative linework and subtle color, and referencing the female form, patterning, cellular structures, systems of language, and mathematical diagrams, Turner's intimate drawings function, at times, like intuitive schematics for that which is ultimately unknowable. She often executes her drawings on antique book paper, treating their creases and tendency to buckle as structural components that inform her interventions. Turner's works on paper hold space for multiple dualities: positive and negative, inner and outer, personal and public, while their contents function equally as entities, subjects, and conceptual frameworks.






Tail Lights, Flowers, Fire, Goose, 2024






Kinke Kooi *Under the Surface*, 2024






Meditation on Vanity, 2024





















Joan Nelson *Untitled*, 2024












