







In 1937, at 31 rue de Seine in Paris, Andre Breton opened a short-lived gallery called GraDiva. He named this after the novel by Wilhelm Jensen and Sigmund Freud's 1907 study Delusion and Dream in Jensen's Gradiva. Upon its opening, Breton commissioned Marcel Duchamp to produce the doorway for the façade of the gallery.

In 2018, Microsoft acquired GitHub, a large open source community and workflow system for the sharing of resources on software development and production. It was a public service of open sources. The founders of GitHub sold the technology and archive to Microsoft for \$7.5M.

There is an alternative version of GitHub called GIT. Software developers and users started to migrate their codes to GIT shortly after GitHub was sold to Microsoft.

The photographs were taken during the Southern and Central California forest fires in 2018, between Santa Barbara and Silicon Valley where GitTub is located. The foil in the photos is an attempt to archive the rock art of the Chumash People.

The exhibition presents a new series of ceramic 'Beauty Masks' made using disposable beauty masks pressed onto layers of clay. The imprint of the synthetic fabric remains on the surface of these flexible faces, which come in a wide range of colours, depending on the glazing process and accidents. Each one of them has particular features, as subjective as a face's thousand variations.


Ingrédients




