For Art Basel 2024, Gomide&Co is pleased to present a selection of artists and artworks with an emphasis on Latin America, along with exponents of Modern Art, inspired by the issues being debated at the current edition of the 60th International Art Exhibition of La Biennale di Venezia.

Curated by Adriano Pedrosa (Artistic Director at Museu de Arte de São Paulo Assis Chateaubriand – MASP), the first Latin American to curate the Venice Biennale, this edition is entitled '*Stranieri Ovunque – Foreigners Everywhere*', a phrase taken from a series of neon sculptures started in 2004 by Claire Fontaine, a Paris-born and Palermo-based collective. The phrase comes, in turn, from the name of a Turin collective that fought racism and xenophobia in Italy in the early 2000s. This edition seeks to highlight the participation of artists from Latin America, Africa, and Asia, debating the condition of the foreigner and the most diverse processes of diaspora around the world, and focusing in the indigenous, queer, and folk art.

In this context, Gomide&Co's proposal for Art Basel 2024 includes a selection of artists whose biographies are marked by displacement (or by being a foreigner in their own territory), as well as self-taught artists or those of indigenous origin. This is the case of Leonora Carrington (England, 1917 – Mexico, 2011), one of the main women artists to form part of the Surrealist group in Paris in the 1920s, who was persecuted by the Nazis during the rise of the Reich. After a dark period in her life, marked by her internment in a sanatorium in Spain, Carrington manages to escape to the Americas, initially to New York and then to Mexico City, where she lived until her death. Also Alejandro Mario Yllanes (Bolivia, 1913 – Mexico, c. 1960), a muralist painter of Aymara ancestry who dedicated his work to denouncing the exploitation and suffering of the indigenous people in mines activity and in the Chaco War (1932–1935) between Bolivia and Paraguay. Persecuted by the

conservative wing of the government that came to power in Bolivia in 1936, after the war, Yllanes went into exile in the Amazon, later following to Chile, Argentina, and Mexico.

The selection also includes several artists taking part in the current edition of the Venice Biennale. Like Julia Isidrez (Paraguay, 1967), an artist of Guaraní origin who is part of the biennale's contemporary group. Her ceramic work involves techniques passed down from generation to generation, and is also marked by the changes resulting from colonization and the conflicts of globalization. Or Amadeo Luciano Lorenzato (Brazil, 1900-1995), featured in the third room of the historical section, dedicated to Italy's artistic diaspora in the 20th century. Born into an Italian immigrant family in the countryside of Belo Horizonte (Brazilian state of Minas Gerais), the country's first planned city, Lorenzato lived in Italy between the 1920s and 1930s, also visiting many places in Eastern Europe during this period. His paintings reflect a lot about his experience in civil construction and the relationship between urban space and the rural outskirts.

Other highlights of the selection include renowned self-taught Brazilian artists such as José Antônio da Silva (São Paulo, 1909-1996), Chico da Silva (Acre, 1910/1922 – Ceará, 1985), Mestre Didi (Bahia, 1917-2013), Agnaldo Manuel dos Santos (Bahia, 1926-1962), Hélio Melo (Acre, 1926 – Goiás, 2001), Maria Lira Marques (Minas Gerais, 1945), and Nilda Neves (Bahia, 1961). Coming from the most diverse regions of the country, the works of these artists reflect on their local realities, also recovering elements of their indigenous and/or African ancestry. And also seminal figures in Modern and Contemporary Art in Brazil, such as Alfredo Volpi (1896-1988), Cândido Portinari (1903-1962), Ivan Serpa (1923-1973), Lygia Pape (1927-2004), Sergio Camargo (1930-1990), and Antonio Dias (1944-2018).


