


Carla Accardi

At this year's Art Basel, **Carla Accardi**'s curated section in our booth presents some of the artist's most iconic pieces spanning from the 1970s to the early 2000s.

Following her initial exploration of white signs on a black background in the mid-1950s, Accardi turned her attention to the relationship between form and space through geometries. In works like *Quattro Triangoli, Sei piccoli trasparenti* and *Quadrato*, colour is concentrated on the very edge of the form, while repetitiveness amplifies the informal content. These works from the late 1970s and early 1980s are crafted with sicofoil, a cellulose acetate, and mounted on frame-like bases of varying shapes. These renowned "transparencies" are characterised by the industrial plastic material that allows light to penetrate. Representing the culmination of her conceptualism, these window-like artworks divert attention to the frame itself, departing from the conventional pictorial aura associated with colourful canyases.


Reflecting on the material, Accardi states: "I have always been open to new things, new mediums, to the extent that, like young people in every era, I avoided using outdated methods. I never purchased an easel. To avoid painting on one, I worked on the floor and then utilised a table. One day, this material arrived at my studio because they wanted to reproduce one of my works. I was intrigued by it. I thought: I want to experiment with it because it might unravel the mysteries behind art."

Dominique Fung | Unlimited

Dominique Fung's explorations span a vast array of subjects, from sea life to artifacts dating back to the Tang and Shang Dynasties. Through these diverse interests, Fung consistently finds herself reconnecting with a distant past that spans oceans and centuries. Her Chinese heritage is deeply intertwined with the objects she encounters, whether at home or during visits to the Asian art section of the Metropolitan Museum of Art in New York. Fung sees these museum relics as reflections of herself, separated from their original contexts by vast distances and the passage of time.

In her exhibited works, seashells morph into blossoming flowers, candle tendrils sprout from Tang dynasty horses, and a complex interplay of hands intertwines with delicate flower stems. Fung's iconic canvases, suffused with a honeyed glow, invite viewers into an allegorical world.

Furthermore, a monumental piece by Fung is on display in the Unlimited section of Art Basel. A Tale of Ancestral Memories is a visual odyssey commissioned by the Art Production Fund in 2023 for the Rockefeller Center in New York. Spanning 88 feet in length and composed of 7 parts (30 canvases in total), A Tale of Ancestral Memories represents Fung's most ambitious work to date. Its debut at Art Basel marks the inaugural unveiling of the work in its intended form.

Jessie Homer French

Jessie Homer French's paintings are explorations of the beauty and fragility of existence, conveyed through soft brushstrokes and a vibrant palette. Immersed in the San Jacinto Mountains, Jessie Homer French is a self-taught artist. In her depictions of environmental catastrophes, blazing fires and the inevitability of death - the end of the world seems incredibly close, and beautiful to look at all at once.

Her familiarity and concern with Californian wildfires are evident, creating a visual narrative that speaks to the power of nature against the human experience. Indeed, Homer French consistently challenges the viewer by simply "painting what she sees", from funerals to wildfires, fish in lakes or stellh bombers speeding across the California sky.




















