

Solo Show – Juliette Minchin Stand M10 – Statements Section

Discover the singular wax sculptures of Juliette Minchin, an important figure on the emerging French art scene. Like a Baroque curiosity cabinet, the booth will bring together a range of emblematic new artworks to dive into her universe. Metal sculptures with wax, installations, draperies, monumental candle, large-scale artwork on paper embalmed in wax will be displayed.

Represented by the gallery since 2022, her practice spans from sculpture and installation to performance and drawing. She works with matter, light, sense of smell and sound to explore ideas related to disappearance and transformation. Her sculptures keep an organic dimension, their surface being often close to the texture of the skin. Research on the fragile balance of the folds and the fall of drapes, has also been at the heart of Juliette Minchin's work in recent years. She has developed a specific type of wax that can be spread, while it is still warm and malleable, like translucent sheets which she drapes over metallic structures.

Marker of time passing, each of her works (often revealed in series) unfolds as an autonomous temporal sequence. Juliette Minchin is inspired by traditions that celebrate the passage of time using wax. She feeds her imagination from commemorative monuments in different cultures. Her large-scale drawings, which she calls *Hydromancie* are composed by the movement of natural pigments and water on paper, then dipped in wax to preserve their color and create a special translucent texture. The way her pieces are staged and their spiritual and memorial character makes one think of a space close to ritual places. On the stand, the wax will be displayed in different states, creating a unique environment.

Juliette Minchin was born in 1992, she lives and works in Paris. She has taken part in numerous exhibitions. Laureate of the "Mondes nouveaux" program organized by the French Ministry of Culture, she presented her monumental installation *La Croix, veillée aux épines* at the Abbaye de Beaulieu-en-Rouergue in 2023, simultaneously with her first solo show at the Gallery. She is currently working on a major site-specific exhibition at the Museo Sant'Orsola in Florence, Italy, which will open in June 2024.

Juliette Minchin practices sculpture, installation, video and drawing. She stages her pieces by working on matter, light, sense of smell and sound. In her work, she mainly explores concepts related to disappearance and transformation. Marker of time passing, each of her works unfolds as an autonomous temporal sequence. The use of natural materials (plaster, earth, wax or liquid) gives her sculptures an undeniably organic dimension whose surface, in its appearance, is close to the skin. The repetition of the same gesture and the random evolution of the material give them a processual aspect.

Juliette Minchin was born in 1992, she lives and works in Paris.
